

2019 CENTER CHALLENGE

This is a One Day, Best of the Best, High Stakes Tournament



Tournament to consist of the top five averages from one center regardless of sex. Minimum games apply. See details below.

Entry Deadline: April 10, 2019 with a \$50 center sponsor per team.

Tournament is a five member scratch event. All entering teams must come from an OSBPA member center as of the time of competition. All entrants must hold a current season USBC membership card and be in good standing in their center. If the tournament does not fill completely the tournament committee has the option to add teams from other states if space allows.

Method of selecting Center Challenge Participants. USBC sanctioned averages in center with a minimum of 50 games as a regular paying member in one league. Average by April 1, 2019. Centers may enter up to 2 teams if space allows. Sport Average Conversion will be considered if the bowler is in a sport league to establish in the high 5. Centers reserve the right to select their choice of the 5 bowlers submitted including the proprietor.

One division comprised of both men and women. All teams will bowl 8 games. Each game except the first is a position round. The match point system will be used - two for individual win, five for each team win. If an odd number of teams are participating, the last three teams will vie for two sets of points. Teams will set their lineup the first and no change may be made until the beginning of the 5th Game. At that point no more lineup changes are allowed.

Two different oil patterns will be set out for the day Game 1-4 then re-oil and 5-8. Shots will be selected from the Kegel Challenge Series.

Total points to determine winner and position. In case of a tie for championship, a one game roll off will be held with one set of points (15) being divided - two for individual win and five for series - among all teams involved to determine the winner.

In the event of an emergency (determined by the tournament committee), substitutions will be allowed in accordance with the qualifying rules.

Payoff will be at least 1 for 4 teams, or major fraction thereof.

Prize fund will be returned 100%.
