Rules and Guidelines

1. **Eligibility:** This tournament is open to all current youth registered Grand Prix Members who have not yet reached the age of 18 as of 8/1/2021.
2. Youth must be pre-registered in the Oregon Grand Prix Program before **May 1st, 2021**.
Entry fee is \$20.00 per bowler, per event: \$9.00 for lineage, \$1.00 expenses and \$10 towards the prize fund. Entries received after June 26th, will be subject to an additional \$5 fee at the door.
3. **Events:** This tournament shall consist of a doubles and singles events bowling 3 games each.
4. Bowlers may enter singles only once, doubles multiple times using a different partner. On-site entries will only be taken on a space available basis. This tournament is not certified by USBC.
4. **Scholarship Awards:** Scholarships are awarded 1 for every 4 entries. In case of a tie for 1st or 2nd place scholarships will be divided equally.
5. **Divisions** with less than 5 entries lose the guarantee of \$200 first place but will be awarded scholarship money on a sliding scale of entries.
6. **Averages:** Entrants will use highest verifiable average of 21 or more games as of May 22nd, 2021 in all leagues. **Standing sheet as of 5-22-21 or USBC average found on bowl.com is required with entry.** Sport or Challenge averages will be accepted using the USBC Conversion chart. If a prior year(s) average exceeds more than 10 pins difference, the higher of the 2 averages will be used. Rule 319 applies. Tournament Director has the right to rerate or disqualify if rules are not met. Falsification of average may result in disqualification of bowler.
7. **Handicap:** Individual handicap based on 90% of 220 in all divisions.
8. **Substitutes:** All substitutes for doubles must have verification of membership, standing sheet and report 1 hr prior to squad time.
9. **Check-In is** 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time of tournament with preregistration. One hour if not preregistered.
10. **Late Arrival:** An entrant arriving late shall be permitted to bowl with his/her score to count beginning with the frame in which he/she starts to bowl. There will be no make up for missed frames.
10. **Protests:** Any disputes occurring on the lanes must be made in writing within 72 hours to Tournament Management.
11. **Bowling Attire:** Bowlers are encouraged to dress in presentable bowling attire. No tank tops, cut offs, short shorts/skirts, hats or headphones permitted. Any violation may result in disqualification.
